We are really excited to welcome you to Aishah Academy!


Aishah Academy has been set up by a group of ulama who have been leading Islamic education provision for many years.

THE COURSE

The 'Aalimah Course comprises a comprehensive and thorough curriculum covering a number of Islamic disciplines, designed to equip students of knowledge with the sciences required to serve as scholars in their communities.

The course begins with an in depth study of classical Arabic language along with other sciences. These gradually develop students to be able to comprehend more advanced and complex texts, a skill required to be able to appreciate and understand some of the traditional texts, upon which much of our learning of Islam stems from.

Students cover a variety of sciences, ranging from Islamic jurisprudence (fiqh) to the study of Hadith with transmission and Quranic exegesis (tafseer). As part of our course, we also develop our student's presentation and public speaking skills thus equipping them with the tools required to pass on their learning and benefit their communities. Students will also develop essential skills enabling them to adapt to their surroundings whilst being confident and proud of their identity as Muslims.

At the end of the course, student are granted ijaazah (permission to transmit hadith) through their own isnaad (continuous chain of narration reaching the Prophet !).





CURRICULUM

The following subjects are taught as part of the course. We have also given a brief description of what is covered.

Classical Arabic
Tajweed
Exegesis (Tafseer)
Principles of Hadeeth (Usool Al-Hadeeth)
Hadīth
Principles of Jurisprudence (Usool Al-Fiqh)
Jurisprudence (Fiqh)
Theology ('Aqeedah)

Classical Arabic

Arabic is an essential tool for understanding the Qur'ān and religious texts. Topics such as syntax (nahw) and morphology (sarf) are taught to equip students with the linguistic skills required for the analysis of the classical texts. Modern Arabic language is also taught.

Tajweed

Students are taught tajweed giving them the skills required to recite the Quran correctly. This is taught theoretically and practically.

Exegesis (Tafseer)

Along with the translation of the Quran, it's tafseer is also taught based on the explanations of the classical scholars. Aditionally, students have opportunities to relate their understanding of the Quran to modern day living.

Principles of Hadīth (Usool Al-Hadeeth)

The study of Usool Al-Hadeeth includes learning the terminologies of Hadeeth and its people; Different types of chains connecting back to the Messenger of Allah (SAW); Hadeeth categories according to the number of people narrating it and much more.

Hadeeth

Throughout the course, students will have various opportunities to study hadeeth. In the final years of the course, they will study some of the choiciest words of the Leader of mankind, Muhammad & including the six authentic books.

Principles of Jurisprudence (Usool Al-Figh)

This is a study of the body of principles and investigative methodologies through which practical legal rules are developed from the foundational sources. These are 1) The Quran 2) Ahadeeth 3) Ijmaa (consensus) 4) Qiyaas (analogy).

Jurisprudence (Figh)

Fiqh (Islamic Jurisprudence) is the study of Islamic law that informs the life of a Muslim. As future scholars, it is imperative that students have an extensive understanding of fiqh, as the majority of queries (masā'il) addressed to them will be regarding matters of fiqh.

Theology (Aqeedah)

An understanding of the core doctrines of Islam is essential to ensure one stays firmly grounded in their faith and is able to protect oneself from innovations. Students are taught how to articulate the central tenets of Islam and respond to questions regarding these tenets.

TEACHING AND LEARNING

We believe that every student deserves the best opportunities to grow and develop to their potential. This belief is the driving factor behind our teaching methods.

Our teachers are passionate about using their knowledge and experience to deliver lessons in a stimulating environment, whereby the classroom becomes a safe zone for students to enhance their learning.

Our lessons are engaging, combining practical and theoretical elements, as in the sunnah of our Beloved Prophet , so that students can gain maximum benefit from each session.

We use a range of mediums in our teaching, including both traditional methods and modern pedagogy, with the ultimate aim of students achieving their best.
